- The top three industries in 2021 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Individual and Family Services.



May 2022 Labor Force Breakdown




Educational Attainment





Unemployment by Gender










Job Trends








Millennials

Retirement risk is high in Bucks County, PA. The national average for an area this size is 186,905 people 55 or older, while there are 224,713 here.




Violent Crime




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Location Quotient








Top Occupation Earnings






